## Tops tips to protect frost sensitive plants



### 1-WATER

Water the soil the night before suspected frosts. Water generates heat as it freezes which actually warms the ground beneath your trees.

### 2-REMOVE WEEDS

Keep the ground below trees weed-free and remove mulch to allow bare soil to warm the tree more effectively.



### 3-FEED

Apply a seaweed solution to the foliage regularly to help prevent frost damage.

### 4-PROTECTION

Cover young trees overnight with a frost protection cloth, cover or bag.



### 5-LIGHT IT UP

Break out the outdoor Christmas lights! These can help to increase temperatures and reduce frost damage.
